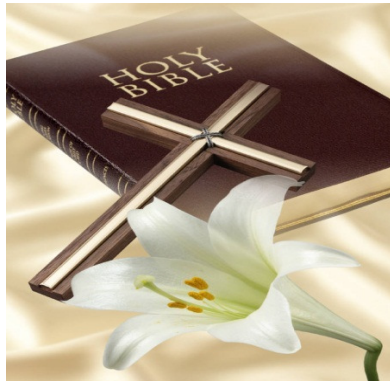

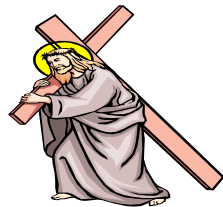
The Rev. Mark Satterly will teach Sunday School on Mar.10th and Aaron Klein (new Chair of Council) will finish the service for him.

Youth Group Spaghetti Dinner

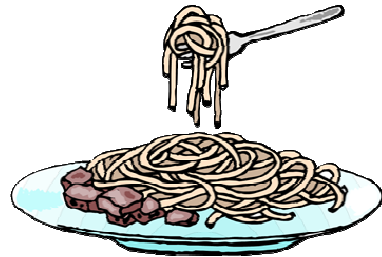
